Chairman's Report - Jenny Young - Summary:

Thank you to the Farmers Club for hosting the AGM this year - we have moved to a weeknight to try and encourage more people to attend.

Thank you to Imogen at Coleys for helping to collect and store trophies for us.

The year started off strong - all county championship dates were organised early, and missing trophies found.

An oversight on my part was to use Barbury for the county STR. We have always used Barbury to host this event, and we thank them for this, but was not aware that Coley's could host this. We always try to use grounds within our county, so we hope Coleys will host this year's STR event.

Sean and Jenny spent a lot of their own time getting trophies engraved and out to winners - a lot were not returned and re-engraved from the previous year, so we hope at this AGM the majority will be awarded on the night.

There was a change made due to the number of people needed to make up a category - this was originally changed to three per class. However, after discussions with Stuart Jones, and the low numbers attending trap events, it was agreed that this will be changed to a minimum of two per category. This can be reviewed later in the meeting if required. Sadly, after this change it seemed the county was divided and enthusiasm was lost.

A couple of trap events did not go ahead this year, and it was noticeable there were no juniors throughout the majority of the disciplines. However, the skeet and sporting events were highly attended.

We put forward teams for the WM IC ESK and ESP - as well as national IC ABT. The committee donated £20 per person for the teams, and all went along with caps and shirts. Sadly there was not enough interest to put forward teams for the Clubman event.

Thank you to Steve Lovatt for donating £300 to the committee, and Pual Tudge for running a very successful fundraiser at the Skeet Club, generously donating £450 to the committee, and Nick Portlock kindly donated his £50 high gun money back to the committee too. Shaurn Porter and Adrian Johnson also donated to the committee as they could not attend the fundraiser.
