A total of 24 shooters turned out for the Greater London County DTL Championships, 16 of which were from Greater London.

This year it was held at the National Clay Shooting Centre at Bisley, and thanks to the staff at the centre for putting on good quality targets and ensuring that everything ran very smoothly. The weather conditions were very good, slightly overcast to start with. Then later on the sun started to break through and but the wind started to pick up a little by the end of the shoot.

The competition was closely fought right up to the last round and was eventually won by Mr RD Heal from Avon with 99/294 this was closely followed by Greater London's Lee Wakefield with 100/292 the only shooter to manage a 100 straight, not only did this win him the Championship it was his first 100 straight. This led to the obligatory shooting of his hat, always a good light hearted end to a day's shooting. The runner up was Kevin Stock with a 97/290, Lisa Sargeant took the ladies title and Sophie Weller was the Colt winner with John Headford taking the Veterans title.
